Voluntary training programme

The Institute offers voluntary training programme to enable interested students to work with CMPR faculty, after completing their Post-graduation. The details are as given below.

Duration: Minimum 6 months to maximum 1 year.

Areas of Research: Pharmacognosy/Plant Tissue Culture/ Molecular Biology/ Phytochemistry

Who can apply: Candidates should have minimum Post Graduation in related area, with 55% marks in the qualifying degree (PG). M.Phil / PhD scholars are also eligible to apply.

How to apply: Download the format of application for voluntary training from the website www.cmpr-avs.in. Filled-in-application form along with the required documents should be submitted either via E-mail or by post. Students may select any two areas of their preference in the space provided, by marking 1 / 2. Generally, applications are considered twice a year for the 6-monthly training programmes conducted during January to June or July to December and once a year for 1-year programme (January to December). If there is a requirement, slight adjustment in month of start of training is permissible, based on vacancy in concerned subject.

Last date for application: November 30 for January batch (both 6 months and 1 year) and May 30 for July batch.

Selection: Selection will be purely based on merit and the vacancies available in each discipline. A merit list will be prepared and if two or more candidates merit score is same, and then preference shall be given to candidates having lower annual income. The selected candidates will be informed via E-mail.

Issue of Certificate: The candidates who complete the training programme for the full period will be issued a Certificate. No certificate will be issued for those who discontinue the training before the completion of training period. However an option of converting the voluntary training programme to a paid training program of shorter duration can be allowed, if for unforeseen genuine reasons the candidate is unable to complete the minimum period of 6 months, and a certificate will be issued for the same.

Accommodation: Candidates will have to arrange their own accommodation.
